Jonathan Rathbone

Jonathan was a choral scholar at Cambridge, and later studied composition at the Royal Academy of Music. In 1984 he joined the

Swingle Singers and was their musical director for a decade, composing and arranging most of their material. He conducts five choirs in north London and is guest conductor of a professional choir in Bergen. Jonathan has made arrangements for Voces 8 and for many other choirs in the UK and abroad. He is also a busy orchestrator. Last year he re-orchestrated Vaughan Williams' 'Dona Nobis Pacem' for Kings College Cambridge. The CD has received wide-spread praise for the orchestration.
